Amalia Hernández and Rodríguez of Nicaragua "A" opened with a 21-15, 21-12 victory over Rut Gomez and Stefany Bolaños of Guatemala "B" and Alvarado/Ramirez tied the series by defeating Torrez/Swan Mendoza of Nicaragua "B" 21-17, 21-17.

Alvarado/Ramirez defeated Hernández/Rodríguez 21-17, 21-12 and once again the series was tied when Torrez/Mendoza beat Gomez/Bolaños 21-11, 21-15 to force the "golden set".

"It was a very well organized event and we are leaving Costa Rica with a positive impression," Arnaldo Sanchez, the technical director, said. "We hope they can continue hosting international events and become a regular stop in our NORCECA Beach Volleyball Circuit."
