Reyna and Estevez romp into quarterfinals at Boca Chica

BOCA CHICA, Dominican Republic, April 23, 2011 – Cuba's Kirenia Reyna and Imara Estevez advanced to the quarterfinals at the Boca Chica Beach Volleyball Tournament with one lopsided 21-0, 21-5 victory over Elki Phillip and Pauline Woodroffe of Trinidad & Tobago on Saturday.

Also advancing to Sunday's quarterfinals were Natalia Alfaro and Ingrid Morales of Costa Rica who crushed Honduras' Gina Flores





and Marta Euceda 21-6, 21-8 and Mexico's Martha Revuelta and Diana Estrada who won 21-12, 21-11 over Jennifer Bily and Cristin Alexander of Cayman Islands.
