



Anguilla canters pass St. Eustatius in tournament opener

St. JOHNS, Antigua, September, 9, 2016 – A 20 point effort from Sherwin Richardson led Anguilla to a straight set victory (25-8, 25-15, and 25-22) over St. Eustatius in the opening match of the ECVA World Cup Qualifying tournament Group A men

It is no secret that #7 (Richardson) is our number one player so you should be surprised that we go to him so often”, he admitted.

Coach Hook was very blunt. I believe some of the guys simply choked. They missed the rotations and they were nowhere near the passing and therefore could not execute. If you notice we put up more resistance in the third set but we should have been tough from set.

Captain Alex Andell underscored Hook’s view. I believe that we drowned ourselves with too many unforced errors especially in the first two sets. If we continue to play like this

we will get beaten off the court”, he lamented. We have to now pick ourselves up and come back with a much better fight”, he concluded.

St. Eustatius meets Antigua and Barbuda in the next game while Anguilla will face Team Montserrat.

Antigua and Barbuda wraps up Montserrat in 60 minutes

St. JOHNS, Antigua, September, 9, 2016 – it took all of 60 minutes for Antigua and Barbuda to record a straight set victory (25-16, 25-13, and 25-8) over Montserrat in the ECVA World Cup Qualifying tournament Group A men

Captain Collin Thomas was a key factor in determining the game. He had 13 kills and 15 points overall as he scored from several positions at the net. Coach Denfield Cadett Morris and assistant coach Dennison Daley both carried playing roles. They both promised to be more competitive in the next game

Morris was very optimistic during his interview. “Overall it was a good game but having said that it was really a baptism by fire as several of them were playing at this level for the first. We attempted some new rotations as we wanted to get a feel of our strength

Antigua/Barbuda records an easy victory over St. Eustatius

St. JOHNS, Antigua, September, 9, 2016 – St. Eustatius put up very little resistance as the home team Antigua/Barbuda strolled home in straight sets (25-6, 25- 16 and 25 - 14) in the third game of the ECVA World Cup Qualifying tournament Group A men.

From the onset it appeared as though Antigua was playing at a higher level than St. Eustatius and the game turned out to be a no contest. The scoreboard supported the theory as Antigua dominated in Spikes with a 30 to 8 advantage and had a 10 to 0 shut out in blocks as well as outstripping St. Eustatius 13 to 5 from the service line.

Coach Carl Williams of Antigua had a reason for this. “We made the game look easy as we executed our rotations as planned. Kudos must go to our team for taking the advantage at the least invitation. I think a lot of this stems from the fact that we don’t play enough competitive games throughout a calendar year to be tournament ready. We have to find a way to fix this”, he stated.

For the second time in as many games Collin Thomas led all scorers with 14 points. He got good support from teammate Adrian Constant with 10 points. No one from St. Eustatius got into double figures.

The tournament continues with a clash between St. Eustatius and Montserrat at 11 am on Saturday 10 September while Anguilla and Antigua/Barbuda lock horns in the curtains game of the same evening.

St. Eustatius ends round robin matches with victory over Montserrat.

Edmond Hook was full of glee and brought a big smile to the post-match interview.

"The guys started to play their game and this time around they did not allow outside elements to affect them. Most importantly they started to believe in themselves and believe that they could win and that was what accounted for the victory. I am satisfied

the way they played overall but Patrick Jantzen had a very good game for the first time and also 15 year old Emilio Spanner who had 7 points, showed up and his efforts were counted", he said.

St. Eustatius games are over with only 1 win they only have a slim mathematical chance of going to the finals. Montserrat on the other hand has one more game against Anguilla on Sunday 11th.

Antigua/Barbuda remains undefeated with win over Anguilla

St. JOHNS, Antigua, September, 10, 2016 – Antigua/Barbuda and Anguilla exhibited a keen and hard fought game in match number 5 of the of the ECVA World Cup Qualifying tournament Group A men. In the end Antigua/Barbuda came away victors in four sets: - 25-21, 17-25, 25-13 and 25 -23

The victory secured Antigua/Barbuda's berth into the finals and they maintained an unbeaten record in round robin play. They now await the result of Anguilla versus Montserrat match to determine the other finalist.

Throughout the game Collin Thomas lived up to expectations and carried the attack for the home team. He ended with 23 points, the most by any player. Those points were made up of 20 successful Spikes from 48 attempts as well as two Blocks and an Ace. Left handed Adrian Constant chipped in with 15 points of his own. Anguilla key offensive weapon Sherwin Richardson also scored big with 19 points and Calvin Samuel contributed 11.

On the team score sheet Antigua led in all the scoring categories. 45 to 34 in Spikes, 11 to 8 in Blocks and 4 to 1 in Serves.

Coach Jason Liburd was not too perturbed during the post-match interview. "These matches always come down to the little things and in the end we made more errors than they did. We had a game plan going into the game and for the most part it worked as we forced them to make some changes That was advantageous to us but in the end our mistakes came at crucial points in the game and they cost us the match", he noted.

His opposite number Carl Williams did not reveal much emotion in his assessment of the game. "It was very good game, we expected the fight; we were prepared for it as has been the case in previous tournaments. However we did most things well except for

our blocking and this is an area we want to improve upon in the finals. We made some assessment of the Anguillans during the tournament and during our game tonight and we will be ready for them once they make it through to the finals”, he surmised.

Anguilla is in a must win situation when they meet Montserrat in the last game of round robin matches. A loss would mean that three teams would be tied and will have to be untangled mathematically before deciding who plays the gold medal match against Antigua.
