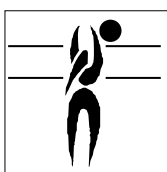

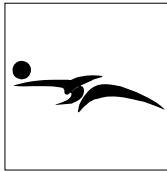

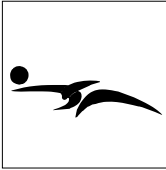

Today we faced a solid opponent, a saw a superlative Cuban team and we must not feel bad of the outcome; tomorrow we'll have to do our best".

**Yokaty Perez, Dominican Republic's captain:** "Nothing was working for us, our leaders weren't taking responsibility during our performance; key spikers didn't execute and if we continue like this we won't be able to win. We had too many errors and Argentina plays tactically, we lacked strength to dominate them. We had no control of the match".

**Guillermo Caceres, Argentina's Head Coach:** "We played well, we had fewer errors than our opponent and we took the lead. There were long rallies and it wasn't easy to score, Dominicans have strength and we needed to be more tactical. I consider that every match here is a final match, all the teams here have good level; it will be a difficult tournament".

**Wagner Pacheco, Dominican Republic's Head Coach:** "Argentina plays very good, this is a team with a lot of experience, they have a lot of years playing together. We need to perform much better, I expected more from my team and I know we could have done it better. During set three we recovered well but we lost focus, this is proof that we can do more".
