IMPORTANT

Competition Format

9.1 Classification, Quarterfinal and Semifinal Rounds

For the Classification, Quarterfinal, and Semifinal Rounds, according to the FIVB General Competition Regulations, it must be avoided that teams from the same group play each other as established in the competition format.

9.2 According to the established competition format and the FIVB General Regulations, for the Classification, Quarterfinal, and Semifinal Rounds, if three teams from the same group qualify, the match between the highest ranked team and the lowest ranked team of their Preliminary Round will be repeated.

9.3 Round Robin Ranking

To establish the ranking of teams after Preliminary Round, the ranking of the teams will be determined as follows:

1. By the results of matches won and lost.
2. In case of equality in the number of matches won and lost, among two or more teams of the same group, the final ranking of the teams will be determined by the number of points gained among teams of the same group during the Preliminary Round.
3. The following points will be awarded to each team per match, according to the number of sets won/lost:

Match won 3-0 = 5 points

Match lost 0-3 = 0 point

Match won 3-1 = 4 points

Match lost 1-3 = 1 points

Match won 3-2 = 3 points

Match lost 2-3 = 2 points

Match forfeited = 0 points (0-25, 0-25, 0-25)

9.4 Tie Breaking Procedure

In case of equality in the number of points gained by two or more teams, the tie will be broken by the points ratio with the following criteria, in order of importance:

- A) **Point Quotient:** In case of equality in the number of points gained by two or several teams they will be classified in descending order by the quotient resulting from the division of all points scored by the total of points lost.
- B) **Set Quotient:** If the tie persists as per the points quotient the teams will be classified in descending order by the quotient resulting from the division of the number of all sets won by the number of all sets lost.
- C) **If the tie continues as per the set quotient between two teams,** the priority will be given to the team which won the last match between them.
- D) **When the tie is between three or more teams** a new classification of these teams will be made taking into consideration only the matches in which they were opposed to each other.



Women's Volleyball Head Coaches in Santiago 2023 give their impressions

SANTIAGO, Chile, October 19, 2023.- The Head Coaches of the teams competing at the Women's Volleyball Tournament of the 2023 Santiago Pan American Games to be held at the Arena Parque O'Higgins, gave their first impressions.

The competition starts on Saturday October 21 with pool-play, with Pool A formed by Brazil, Argentina, Puerto Rico and Cuba, and Pool B consisting of defending champions Dominican Republic, Colombia, Mexico and Chile.

Daniel Jorge Castellani, Head Coach of Argentina: "We are really excited to be at the Pan American Games, an event which all the athletes and coaches wait for. Our team is a combination, with some players that were at the pre-Olympic, some senior players and we introduced five or six U21 players. Our goal will be to battle and play our best possible, to finish among the top three in our pool and then battle for the medals".

Paulo do Rego Barros Junior, Head Coach of Brazil: "I am proud, happy to be at the Pan American Games here in Chile. An important tournament for Brazil. A great opportunity to develop players and some other ones who are beginning their experience at professional volleyball level and it's an important competition that we must make the best out of it and have fun. The team is a combination of young players and some who played at the U21 world championships, others that played in the senior team season and others who are having their first experience with the national team".

Eduardo Guillaume, Head Coach of Chile: "It's a great responsibility to play the Pan American Games at home, we are very happy because I've been in Chile for 7 years and this is the first time we've been playing all over Chile. We played in New Zealand and yesterday we finished playing a tour with Mexico and I liked the response of the fans, they always respond well, they go to support and motivate the team. I see that my players have been taking it with enthusiasm the fact to play here in front of their supporters. When I arrived in Chile, there were some under-18 players, some younger ones, and some veterans who joined the group last year. Then there's the core, which is very young, a group of girls born between 2003 and 2005. I started working with them when they were 14 years old, and we have a fairly young mixed team. All the teams here faced some difficulties but thanks to the Federation's management, we were fortunate to train in a sports complex where we had a very pleasant experience with the people and the facilities. We train every day, and in the past week, we played three matches in three different locations. We will take it one game at a time. Chile is the team with the lowest ranking in this event. The Pan American Games always feature eight high-level teams, and as the host, we automatically qualified. But we know that each of our games will be like a final because our rivals have a higher ranking than ours, and these are typically tough matches".

Leivis García, Head Coach of Cuba: "Cuba is presenting a very young team, with 75% of its composition being players under 21. The goal is to put on a show, introduce new athletes to this level of volleyball, and fight point by point, game by game, to achieve results in line with our effort. We come from winning a bronze medal at the Central American and Caribbean Games and in the Final Six in Canada. It's a pity that this event coincides with several players already competing with their international clubs, which means we won't be able to follow up with the team".

Antonio Rizola, Head Coach of Colombia: “We are proud because in 2019, we participated in our first Pan American Games and reached the final surprising everyone. Today, all of Colombia expects a medal from this team, but that’s not the case because the Games are outside the National team period. We have brought a team with an average age of 20 years, including three 16-year-old athletes, one who is a starter. This means that we have already started our process for 2028. These players have a projection for 8 to 10 years. It is a joy to represent Colombia in such an important competition as the Pan American Games with a young team, always supported by veterans like Juliana Toro and Camila Gómez, the team captain. When we returned from the qualifying tournament in Poland, the main senior players stayed in Europe and did not return to Colombia. After giving the athletes 5 days of rest, we began preparing for the Games. We understand that the Dominican Republic is the strongest team in this championship, as they are the only team with a complete roster in our group. We must fight for the second spot with Chile and Mexico. Mexico also has many problems, and Chile has prepared well, so these will be tough matches”.

Leivis García, Entrenador de Cuba: “Cuba se presenta con un equipo muy joven en donde el 75 % de su composición son jugadoras Sub-21. El objetivo es dar un espectáculo, incursionar a las atletas nuevas a este nivel de voleibol, luchando punto a punto, partido a partido y obtener el resultado de acuerdo con el esfuerzo. Venimos de haber ganado medalla de bronce en los Juegos Centroamericanos y del Caribe y en el Final Six en Canadá. Es una lástima que este evento coincida con varias jugadoras ya jugando con sus clubes a nivel internacional, porque no podremos darle seguimiento al equipo”.

Marcos Kwiek, Head Coach of Dominican Republic: “We are very excited. Representing the country is always something very important and beautiful and we hope for a tournament with many successes. The team is practically coming with the complete roster for the Games, which was planned from the beginning. We already had three competitions as a priority this year, and the Pan American Games were one of them. We returned from the Olympic qualifying tournament in China, and the team was already in high spirits because we achieved our goal. Before coming to the Pan American Games, we had a training base in Brazil, and we worked very well. All the players are in good physical shape, prepared to bring a medal to the country.”

Nicola Negro, Entrenador de México: “First of all, we are very happy to be in this important competition. This marks the end of a very long season for us, our seventh competition during the season. Our preparation was somewhat affected because in the last few days, some players had already left to compete with their clubs and have since returned to Europe. Fortunately, we could field the same squad that played in the pre-Olympic tournament in China last month. That tournament allowed us to face high-level teams and served as preparation for a good Pan American Games. Our goal is the same as all the other teams here: to seek a medal. We know that the competition will be tough, and there are clear favorites like the Dominican Republic and Brazil, but I also see a balance, I think the battle for the podium is open”.

Juan Carlos Rodríguez, Head Coach of Puerto Rico: “I am glad to be here. It’s the first time I will be with the team as head coach, I’ve been working this summer as an assistant coach and now I will

guide these young players. I am glad because it's a group of veterans with young players and we expect to play game by game looking for the victory and giving our all. The message is for them to enjoy the game, to play with confidence, with confidence of what they will perform and for them to look for the win. The new members of the team are mostly the ones who play the U19 world championships and one who comes for the NCAA".

SANTIAGO, Chile, 19 de octubre de 2023.- Los entrenadores de los equipos que competirán en el torneo de Voleibol Femenino de los Juegos Panamericanos Santiago 2023 a celebrarse en la Arena Parque O'Higgins, dieron sus primeras impresiones.

La competencia inicia el sábado 21 de octubre con la ronda de grupos, con el Grupo A conformado por Brasil, Argentina Puerto Rico y Cuba, y el Grupo B por el campeón defensor República Dominicana, Colombia, México y Chile.

Daniel Jorge Castellani, Entrenador de Argentina: "Estamos muy emocionados de estar en los Juegos Panamericanos, un evento que todos los atletas y los entrenadores esperan. Nuestro plantel es mixto, conformado de algunas jugadoras que jugaron en el preolímpico, unas jugadoras mayores e incorporamos otras cinco o seis Sub-21. El objetivo será pelear y jugar lo mejor posible, estar entre los primeros tres del grupo y luego ganar para pelear por las medallas".

Paulo do Rego Barros Junior, Entrenador de Brasil: "Me siento muy orgulloso, muy contento de estar en los Juegos Panamericanos aquí en Chile. Una competencia muy importante para Brasil. Una gran oportunidad de desarrollar las jugadoras y otras para que comiencen con la experiencia de voleibol profesional y es una competencia muy importante que debemos aprovechar y divertirnos. Estamos con un equipo mezclado, jugadoras jóvenes y jugadoras que estuvieron en el mundial Sub-21 y otras que participaron de esta temporada con la selección mayor y también jugadoras que están jugando por la selección nacional por primera vez".

Eduardo Guillaume, Entrenador de Chile: "Jugar los Juegos Panamericanos en casa es una responsabilidad enorme, estamos muy contentos, porque llevo 7 años en Chile y esta es la primera vez que hacemos una gira por acá por Chile. Ya hicimos una gira con Nueva Zelanda y ayer terminamos la gira con México y me gustó mucho la respuesta del público ya que siempre responden bien, van a los espectáculos y alientan al equipo. Veo que las jugadoras también la están tomando con gran entusiasmo el hecho de poder jugar acá delante de su gente. El equipo es un equipo de jugadoras que cuando yo llegué a Chile habían algunas Sub-18, otras más chicas y a ese grupo se agregaron algunas veteranas que entraron el año pasado y luego la base, que es muy joven, un grupo de chicas 2003-2005 que es un grupo que comencé a trabajarlas desde que tenían 14 años y tenemos un equipo mixto bastante joven. Todos los equipos acá tuvieron algunas dificultades, nosotros por suerte por gestión de la Federación llegamos a un polideportivo donde terminamos entrenando con una experiencia muy agradable por la gente y las facilidades. Entrenamos todos los días y esta última semana jugando tres partidos en tres localidades diferentes. Jugaremos parados a partido, Chile es el equipo de menor ranking en este evento. Los Juegos Panamericanos siempre son ocho equipos de gran nivel y como local clasificamos automáticamente, pero sabemos que cada partido nuestro

será como una final porque son rivales de mayor ranking al nuestro y que usualmente son partidos difíciles”.

Antonio Rizola, Entrenador de Colombia: “Estamos orgullosos porque en 2019 disputamos nuestros primeros Juegos Panamericanos y llegamos a la final, sorprendiendo a todos. Hoy toda Colombia espera una medalla de este equipo y no es así, los Juegos están fuera de período de las selecciones. Traemos un equipo que la media de edad es de 20 años, tengo tres atletas de 16 años, una de ellas es titular y esto quiere decir que ya empezamos nuestro proceso para el 2028, son jugadoras con una proyección para 8 a 10 años. Es una alegría poder representar a Colombia en una competencia tan importante como son los Juegos Panamericanos con un equipo joven apoyadas siempre de las veteranas Juliana Toro y Camila Gómez, capitana del equipo. Cuando llegamos del clasificatorio de Polonia las jugadoras principales mayores ya se quedaron en Europa, no regresaron a Colombia luego dimos 5 días de descanso a los atletas y comenzamos la preparación para los Juegos. Dominicana entendemos que está arriba de todos en este campeonato, es el único equipo que está completo y está en nuestro grupo. Nosotros tenemos que pelear por el segundo cupo con Chile y México. México tiene también muchos problemas y Chile se preparó muy bien y serán partidos difíciles”.

Leivis García, Entrenador de Cuba: “Cuba se presenta con un equipo muy joven en donde el 75 % de su composición son jugadoras Sub-21. El objetivo es dar un espectáculo, incursionar a las atletas nuevas a este nivel de voleibol, luchando punto a punto, partido a partido y obtener el resultado de acuerdo con el esfuerzo. Nicola Negro, Entrenador de México: “Primero de todo estamos muy feliz de estar en esta competencia tan importante. Este llega al final de una temporada muy larga, es nuestra séptima competencia durante nuestra temporada. Claramente la preparación fue un poco influenciada porque los últimos días algunas jugadoras ya se fueron a participar con sus clubes, regresado a Europa más felizmente pudimos presentarnos con el mismo elenco que jugó el mes pasado el torneo preolímpico en China. Fue un torneo que nos dio la posibilidad de haber jugado contra equipos de gran nivel y nos sirvió de preparación para disputar unos buenos Juegos Panamericanos. Nuestro objetivo es el mismo de todos los equipos que están participando aquí, buscar una medalla. Sabemos que será un nivel de competencia importante y tenemos claros que están algunos favoritos

como República Dominicana y Brasil, pero también veo mucho equilibrio, pienso que está muy abierta la lucha por el pódium”.

Juan Carlos Rodríguez, Entrenador de Puerto Rico: “Estoy muy contento. Es la primera vez que voy a estar con el grupo ya que he estado trabajando este verano como asistente y me tocó ahora guiar a estas jóvenes. Me siento bien contento porque es un grupo de veteranas con novatas y esperamos ir juego a juego buscando la victoria y dando el máximo de nosotros. El mensaje es que ellas se disfruten el partido, que vayan con mucha confianza, seguridad en lo que van a hacer y que busquen la victoria. Las integrantes nuevas son muchas del Mundial Sub-19 y una jugadora que viene del NCAA”.
