Mexico, Argentina, Brazil, and Guatemala Open with Strong Starts

ASUNCIÓN, Paraguay, August 17, 2025. – Mexico, Argentina, Brazil, and Guatemala kicked off the men's volleyball tournament at the II Junior Pan American Games Asunción 2025 with strong performances as play began at the Paraguayan Olympic Committee (COP) Arena.

Mexico 3, Colombia 1

Mexico opened with a victory by defeating Colombia 3-1 (18-25, 25-18, 25-23, 26-24) in the opening match. The match began with Colombian dominance thanks to the aggressive serving of Dainer Ocoro and Ronnie Mosquera, who put pressure on Mexico's reception to secure the first set. Mexico, however, responded in the second set, taking control early and building a six-point lead (20-14), driven by the offense of Jorge Hernández and opposite hitter Eduardo Garza. The third set had the flavor of a comeback: Mexico recovered from a four-point deficit (13-17) after several consecutive Colombian errors. Leonardo Maldonado and Daniel Cravioto were key in leveling the score at 18, and a spike by Juan García closed the set, giving Mexico a 2-1 lead. The fourth set was the most contested. Colombia tied at 15 points with plays from Miguel Ángel Rodríguez and Santiago Ramírez, keeping the score tight until the end. A Colombian blocking error and a powerful spike from Hernández sealed Mexico's 26-24 win. Mexico led in attacks (56-40), while Colombia held the edge in blocks (11-9) and conceded fewer errors (24-34). Both teams scored 5 aces. Jorge Hernández and Leonardo Maldonado led Mexico with 19 points each; Hernández all on kills, while Maldonado contributed 15 attacks, 2 blocks, and 2 aces. Opposite hitter Eduardo Garza added 10 points.

For Colombia, captain Jhon Mosquera topped the scoring with 18 points (14 attacks, 3 blocks, 2 aces), followed by Miguel Ángel Rodríguez with 11 (7 attacks, 3 blocks, 1 ace). In the second day of Pool A, Mexico will face Guatemala, while Colombia will take on host Paraguay.

Argentina 3, Cuba 2

Argentina dug deep to overcome Cuba in a marathon five-set thriller 3-2 (25-21, 26-24, 21-25, 23-25, 16-14), in the opening match of Pool B. The first set was even until 15-all, when Argentina took control through the power of captain Pablo Cabañas and Nahuel Rojas, while Alejandro González kept Cuba in contention. The second set brought a dramatic finish. Cuba reached set point with a spike from Bryan Camino, but Argentina denied them with a block and an ace by Nahuel García, tying the score at 24. A block from Iván Pavón and a Cuban reception error on García's serve handed Argentina the 2-0 lead. Cuba struck back in the third, powered by the serves of Thiago Suárez and the attacks of Yusniel González, narrowing the gap. The fourth set was a nail-biter, with constant ties. Thiago gave Cuba set point, and Jakdiel Contreras sealed it with a block to force a decisive tie-break. The fifth set was a rollercoaster. Argentina surged ahead 13-8, but Cuba rallied to level at 13-13 after capitalizing on errors. With the score locked at 14-14, Cabañas delivered a crushing spike and then forced a Cuban net violation to clinch the battle for the South Americans. Argentina took advantage of 33 Cuban errors (against 25 of their own), while Cuba led in attacks (61-58), blocks (14-12), and service aces (9-8). Argentinean team captain, Pablo Cabañas led all scorers with 29 points (25 attacks, one block, three aces), followed by Nahuel Rojas with 22. For Cuba, Alejandro González tallied 22 points, Yusniel González added 20, and Bryan Camino finished with 17. Action continues Monday in Pool B with Argentina vs. Brazil and Cuba vs. Dominican Republic.



Brazil 3, Dominican Republic 0

Brazil made a strong debut defeating the Dominican Republic in straight sets 3-0 (25-20, 25-17, 25-23). In the next matches of Pool B, Brazil (1-0) will face Argentina (1-0), while the Dominican Republic (0-1) takes on Cuba (0-1). Team captain Samuel de Morais led Brazil's offense in the opening set, supported by Witallo de Sousa and Maicon dos Santos, while Adrián Figueroa was the main scoring weapon for the Caribbean team. In the second set, tied at 12, Figueroa's serving put Brazil's reception under pressure, but Samuel responded with back-to-back aces to give his team a 15-13 lead. From there, Brazil stayed in control with key contributions from Guilherme Amorim. The third set was tighter, reaching 20-20. Two Dominican errors and a spike by Maicon dos Santos put Brazil ahead 22-20. Although Luther Rosario closed the gap with a powerful attack, another Dominican mistake sealed Brazil's straight-set victory. Brazil held the edge in all categories: attacks (43-35), blocks (7-3), and service aces (8-5). Both teams committed 17 unforced errors. Brazilians Samuel de Morais and Witallo de Sousa topped the scorings with 17 and 14 points respectively. Samuel also delivered a match-high 4 aces. Maicon dos Santos added 10 points. For the Dominican Republic, Adrián Figueroa led with 13 points, followed by Malik Britton with 10.

Guatemala 3, Paraguay 1

Guatemala opened strong defeating host Paraguay 3-1 (26-24, 25-20, 20-25, 25-19) in Pool A action. With this result, Guatemala (1-0) will face Mexico (1-0) in their next match, while Paraguay (0-1) will look for their first win against Colombia (0-1). The Guatemalan squad had to rally from a slow start in the first set, as Paraguay responded with an ace and a spike from Alejandro López to tie the score at 21-21. After a thrilling finish, the Central Americans claimed the set thanks to an opponent's error. In the second set, Guatemala pulled ahead after point 16, fueled by captain Jerry Durán and José Pablo Pérez, maintaining the lead until closing 25-20, also capitalizing on the home team's mistakes. Paraguay answered back in the third set, with López, José Gaete, and Tobías Brizuela leading an offensive surge to build a comfortable 14-9 lead and extend the match to a fourth set. Guatemala quickly took control of the fourth with contributions from Durán, Pérez, and middle blocker José Luis Samayoa. Although Paraguay closed the gap late, a service error and a block by Pérez sealed the victory for the Central Americans. Guatemala capitalized on 32 Paraguayan errors while committing only 16. Paraguay, however, held the advantage in attacks (60-56), blocks (8-7), and aces (4-1). Juan Pablo Pérez and Jerry Durán led Guatemala with 18 points apiece, supported by 10 from José López. For Paraguay, Alejandro López stood out as the top scorer of the match with 27 points (23 kills, 2 blocks, 2 aces), followed by Gaete with 13, and Brizuela and Milton Martínez with 11 each.

México, Argentina, Brasil y Guatemala inician con paso firme

ASUNCIÓN, Paraguay, 17 de agosto de 2025.— México, Argentina, Brasil y Guatemala debutaron con paso firme el torneo de voleibol masculino de los II Juegos Panamericanos Junior Asunción 2025, que inició en la Arena del Comité Olímpico Paraguayo (COP).

México 3, Colombia 1

México debutó con victoria al superar a Colombia 3-1 (18-25, 25-18, 25-23, 26-24) en el partido inaugural. El encuentro inició con dominio colombiano gracias al servicio agresivo de Dainer Ocoro y Ronnie Mosquera, quienes complicaron la recepción mexicana para cerrar el primer parcial a su favor. Sin embargo, México reaccionó en el segundo set tomando el control desde el inicio y asegurando una ventaja de seis puntos (20-14), impulsados por la ofensiva de Jorge Hernández y el opuesto Eduardo Garza. El tercer set tuvo tintes de remontada: los mexicanos se recuperaron de un déficit de cuatro puntos (13-17) tras varios errores consecutivos de Colombia. Leonardo Maldonado y Daniel Cravioto fueron claves en la igualdad a 18 tantos, y un remate de Juan García selló el 2-1 parcial para México. El cuarto episodio fue el más disputado. Colombia logró empatar a 15 puntos con acciones de Miguel Ángel Rodríguez y Santiago Ramírez, manteniendo la tensión hasta el final. Un error de bloqueo colombiano y un potente ataque de Hernández cerraron el triunfo mexicano 26-24. México dominó en ataques (56-40), mientras Colombia fue superior en bloqueos (11-9) y cometió menos errores (24-34). Ambos equipos sumaron 5 aces. Jorge Hernández y Leonardo Maldonado lideraron la ofensiva mexicana con 19 puntos cada uno; Hernández todos por ataque, y Maldonado con 15 ataques, 2 bloqueos y 2 aces. El opuesto Eduardo Garza agregó 10 unidades. Por Colombia, el capitán Jhon Mosquera fue el máximo anotador con 18 puntos (14 ataques, 3 bloqueos y 2 aces), seguido por Miguel Ángel Rodríguez con 11 (7 ataques, 3 bloqueos y un ace). En la segunda jornada del Grupo A, México enfrentará a Guatemala, mientras que Colombia se medirá ante el anfitrión Paraguay.

Argentina 3, Cuba 2

Argentina necesitó de todo su empuje para imponerse a Cuba en un maratónico duelo de cinco sets 3-2 (25-21, 26-24, 21-25, 23-25, 16-14), en el arranque del Grupo B. El primer set fue parejo hasta el 15 iguales, momento en el que Argentina tomó el control gracias a la potencia del capitán Pablo Cabañas y de Nahuel Rojas, mientras Alejandro González mantenía a Cuba en la pelea. El segundo parcial tuvo un cierre vibrante. Cuba acarició la victoria con el ataque de Bryan Camino, pero Argentina resistió: un bloqueo y un ace de Nahuel García igualaron el marcador a 24. Luego, un bloqueo de Iván Pavón y un error cubano en la recepción le dieron a la albiceleste la ventaja 2-0. Cuba reaccionó en el tercer set con los servicios de Thiago Suárez y los ataques de Yusniel González, que aseguraron el descuento. La tensión creció en el cuarto capítulo, con empates constantes y un cierre dramático: Thiago puso a Cuba en match point y Jakdiel Contreras lo selló con un bloqueo para forzar el tie-break. El desempate fue un carrusel de emociones. Argentina se adelantó 13-8, pero Cuba igualó 13-13 tras aprovechar errores rivales. Con el marcador 14-14, apareció la figura de Cabañas, primero con un ataque demoledor y luego provocando un error cubano en la red que cerró la batalla a favor de los sudamericanos. Argentina capitalizó 33 errores de Cuba (contra 25 propios), mientras que los caribeños dominaron en ataques (61-58), bloqueos (14-12) y saques directos (9-8). El argentino Pablo Cabañas, capitán del

equipo, fue máximo anotador del partido con 29 puntos (25 ataques, un bloqueo, 3 aces), secundado por Nahuel Rojas con 22. Por Cuba, Alejandro González brilló con 22 tantos, Yusniel González aportó 20 y Bryan Camino 17. La acción continuará este lunes en el Grupo B con Argentina vs. Brasil y Cuba vs. República Dominicana.

Brasil 3, República Dominicana 0

Brasil debutó con autoridad superando en sets corridos a República Dominicana 3-0 (25-20, 25-17, 25-23). En la próxima jornada del Grupo B, Brasil (1-0) va contra Argentina (1-0) y República Dominicana (0-1) ante Cuba (0-1). El capitán Samuel de Morais lideró la ofensiva brasileña en el primer parcial, respaldado por Witallo de Sousa y Maicon dos Santos, mientras que Adrián Figueroa fue la principal arma ofensiva del conjunto caribeño. En el segundo set, tras un empate a 12, el servicio de Figueroa complicó la recepción de Brasil, pero Samuel respondió con dos aces consecutivos para tomar la ventaja 15-13. A partir de ahí, Brasil mantuvo el control con aportes de Guilherme Amorim. El tercer parcial fue más disputado, llegando igualados 20-20. Dos errores dominicanos y un ataque de Maicon dos Santos dieron ventaja a Brasil 22-20. Aunque un remate de Luther Rosario acercó a República Dominicana, un nuevo error selló el triunfo brasileño en sets corridos. Brasil dominó en todos los fundamentos: ataques (43-35), bloqueos (7-3) y saques directos (8-5). Ambos equipos cometieron 17 errores no forzados. Los brasileños Samuel de Morais y Witallo de Sousa fueron los máximos anotadores del partido con 17 y 14 puntos respectivamente. Samuel además anotó 4 aces, el máximo del partido. Además, Maicon dos Santos aportó 10 puntos. Por República Dominicana, Adrián Figueroa lideró con 13 puntos y Malik Britton sumó 10.

Guatemala 3, Paraguay 1

Guatemala inició con paso firme al derrotar al anfitrión Paraguay 3-1 (26-24, 25-20, 20-25, 25-19) en el Grupo A. Con este resultado, Guatemala (1-0) enfrentará a México (1-0) en su próximo compromiso, mientras que Paraguay (0-1) buscará su primera victoria frente a Colombia (0-1). El conjunto guatemalteco tuvo que remontar un inicio adverso en el primer set, donde Paraguay reaccionó con un ace y ataque de Alejandro López para igualar el marcador en 21-21. Tras un cierre emocionante, los centroamericanos se impusieron gracias a un error del rival. En el segundo parcial, Guatemala sacó ventaja a partir del punto 16 con el empuje ofensivo del capitán Jerry Durán y José Pablo Pérez, manteniendo la diferencia hasta cerrar 25-20, favorecido también por los desaciertos del conjunto local. La reacción paraguaya llegó en el tercer set, con López, José Gaete y Tobías Brizuela liderando un ataque que les permitió tomar una cómoda ventaja (14-9) y forzar el cuarto set. Guatemala no dejó escapar la oportunidad y tomó rápidamente el control del cuarto parcial con el aporte de Durán, Pérez y el central José Luis Samayoa. Aunque Paraguay intentó recortar distancias, un error de servicio y un bloqueo de Pérez sellaron la victoria de los centroamericanos. Guatemala aprovechó 32 errores de Paraguay, mientras que solo cometió 16. Los locales, sin embargo, dominaron en ataques (60-56), bloqueos (8-7) y servicios (4-1). Juan Pablo Pérez y Jerry Durán fueron los líderes de Guatemala con 18 puntos cada uno, acompañados por los 10 de José López. Por Paraguay, Alejandro López brilló con 27 puntos (23 ataques, 2 bloqueos, 2 aces) como máximo anotador del encuentro, seguido por Gaete con 13 y Brizuela y Milton Martínez con 11 cada uno.
