Brazil Wins Back-to-Back Pan Am Junior Title and Secures Spot in Lima 2027

ASUNCIÓN, Paraguay, August 22, 2025. Brazil claimed back-to-back gold in the men's volleyball tournament at the II Junior Pan American Games Asunción 2025, after defeating Argentina in a dramatic five-set final 3-2 (22-25, 25-15, 22-25, 27-25, 15-3) at the Arena COP, also securing their qualification to the 2027 Pan American Games in Lima.

Brazil closed the event undefeated with a 5-0 record, while Argentina (4-2) suffered its only two losses against the Brazilians, both in extended five-set battles.

Argentina started strong in the opening set, jumping to a 6-0 lead behind Denis Cabañas and Nahuel Rojas, along with a block from Nicolás Oldani. Brazil calmly worked their way back, tying at 14 thanks to blocks from Witallo de Sousa and Thierry Oliveira. However, a late surge by Cabañas sealed the set 25-22 for Argentina.

In the second set, Brazil responded with a more organized game, led by Samuel Carazzai, Maicon dos Santos, and Juan Pablo da Gama. With an attack from Witallo and an Argentine error, the Brazilians closed 25-15 to even the match.

The third set was once again balanced. Brazil led 16-13 with Carazzai and Witallo as key figures, but Argentina regained control down the stretch with Rojas and Cabañas, taking it 25-22 for a 2-1 lead.

In the fourth, Argentina built a 9-4 advantage, but Brazil rallied to tie at 11. The set remained tight until the end, when Argentina earned two match points. However, costly errors allowed Brazil to recover and force a tie-break with a 27-25 win.

The fifth set was all Brazil: with intensity and precision, the defending champions dominated 15-3 against an error-prone Argentina to secure the title.

Brazil led in attacks (62-51) and blocks (16-8), while both sides finished with 7 service points. Errors were nearly identical: 27 from Brazil and 26 from Argentina.

Brazilian outside hitter Samuel Carazzai topped all scorers with 31 points, including a match-high 5 aces. He was supported by Maicon dos Santos with 21 points and Guilherme Amorim with 16. For Argentina, captain Denis Cabañas scored 24 points (4 aces), followed by Nahuel Rojas with 18 and Nahuel García with 12.

Bronze Medal – Cuba3, Mexico 1

Cuba captured the bronze medal after defeating Mexico 3-1 (22-25, 25-13, 25-18, 25-23), also earning a berth to the Lima 2027 Pan American Games as the highest-ranked NORCECA team. Mexico started strong thanks to the offensive power of Jared Toy and Eduardo Garza, taking an early lead in the opening set (10-8). Despite Cuba's attempts at the net, Mexico kept control and pulled ahead on the scoreboard. The Cuban squad bounced back decisively in the second set, surging to a 14-5 lead with Alejandro González and middle blocker Thiago Suárez leading the way. Blocking became Cuba's main weapon, with Yusniel González and



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Alexis Wilson joining the wall at the net to tie the match. In the third set, Alejandro González's powerful serves pushed Cuba ahead 11-4. Mexico responded with Toy and Jorge Hernández, but the Caribbean side held their advantage to move in front 2-1. The fourth set was a nail-biter, with Mexico leading 18-16 after Cuban errors and an ace by Alexis Alvarado. However, Thiago Suárez and Yusniel González turned the tide for Cuba, sealing the victory, the bronze medal, and the qualification to Lima 2027. Statistically, Cuba dominated with a huge margin in blocks (14-4), attacks (55-45), and a slight edge in serves (3-2), though they conceded more points on errors (28-25). Cuban opposite hitter Alejandro González topped all scorers with 23 points (17 attacks, 4 blocks, 2 aces), followed by Yusniel González with 18 (14 attacks, 3 blocks, 1 ace), and Thiago Suárez with 12 (9 attacks, 3 blocks). For Mexico, Jared Toy led with 15 points and Jorge Hernández added 11.

Dominican Republic 3, Colombia 2

The Dominican Republic secured fifth place after defeating Colombia in an exciting five-set battle 3-2 (25-20, 25-19, 21-25, 19-25, 15-10). The Dominican team closed the tournament with a 2-3 record, while Colombia finished with 2-4. The Caribbean side dominated the first two sets thanks to their offense and the serving of Malik Britton and Adrian Figueroa, which disordered Colombia's reception. However, the South Americans responded with strong blocking to even the match and force a decider, where the Dominicans ultimately prevailed. The Dominican Republic led in attacks (65-56) and aces (6-5), while Colombia excelled in blocking (11-8) and committed one fewer error (26-27). Adrian Figueroa topped all scorers with 28 points (25 attacks, 3 aces). Ronny Molina added 15 points, Malik Britton contributed 14, and Moisés Ortiz chipped in 10 for the Dominican Republic. For Colombia, captain Jhon Mosquera led his side with 20 points (16 attacks, 3 blocks, 1 ace), supported by Miguel Rodríguez with 16, while Ronnie Mosquera and Carlos Martínez each scored 13.

Guatemala 3, Paraguay 2

Guatemala wrapped up with a 3-2 victory over Paraguay (18-25, 25-22, 22-25, 26-24, 15-13), securing seventh place. The Guatemalan squad closed with a record of 2 wins and 4 losses; both wins over Paraguay who finished without a victory in the competition. The hosts were close to sealing the match in four sets, but Guatemala rallied from a four-point deficit (20-24) in the fourth set to force a tie-break. The celebration came with an attack from Yeferson Zavala that sealed the win. Guatemala held a slight edge in serving (5-4) and capitalized on 30 Paraguayan errors compared to their own 24. Both teams scored 63 attack points, while Paraguay held a huge margin in blocking 18-8. Pablo Pérez led Guatemala with 19 points (18 attacks, 1 block), followed by team captain Jerry Durán with 18 (16 attacks, 1 block, 1 ace) and Luis Mendizábal with 14 (11 attacks, 2 blocks, 1 ace). For Paraguay, Alejandro López shone as the top scorer of the match with 35 points, supported by Milton Pérez with 14 (11 attacks, 2 blocks, 1 ace), Elías Amarilla with 11, and both Tobías Brizuela and Ángel Sánchez with 10 each.

Brasil conquista Bicampeonato Panamericano Junior y clasifica a Lima 2027

ASUNCIÓN, Paraguay, 22 de agosto de 2025.- Brasil se proclamó bicampeón del torneo de voleibol masculino de los II Juegos Panamericanos Junior Asunción 2025, tras imponerse a Argentina en una dramática final de cinco sets 3-2 (22-25, 25-15, 22-25, 27-25, 15-3), disputada en la Arena COP, asegurando además su clasificación a los Juegos Panamericanos de Lima 2027.

Brasil cerró el torneo invicto con récord 5-0, mientras que Argentina (4-2) sufrió sus dos únicas derrotas precisamente ante los brasileños, ambas en parciales extendidos.

Argentina arrancó con fuerza en el primer set, logrando ventaja de 6-0 con aportes de Denis Cabañas y Nahuel Rojas, además del bloqueo de Nicolás Oldani. Brasil reaccionó con paciencia y logró igualar a 14, gracias al bloqueo de Witallo de Sousa y Thierry Oliveira. Sin embargo, un cierre contundente de Cabañas selló el 25-22 para los argentinos.

Brasil respondió en el segundo parcial con un juego más ordenado, liderado por Samuel Carazzai, Maicon dos Santos y Juan Pablo da Gama. Con un ataque de Witallo y un error argentino, los brasileños cerraron cómodamente 25-15 para empatar el marcador.

El tercer set fue nuevamente equilibrado. Brasil se adelantó 16-13 con Carazzai y Witallo como protagonistas, pero Argentina retomó el control en la recta final con ataques de Rojas y Cabañas, llevándose el parcial 25-22 para el 2-1.

En el cuarto set, Argentina tomó ventaja 9-4, aunque Brasil reaccionó para igualar a 11. La paridad se mantuvo hasta el cierre, cuando Argentina llegó a tener dos puntos de partido. Sin embargo, los errores le costaron caro y Brasil forzó el tie-break 27-25.

El quinto set fue totalmente brasileño: con un juego intenso y sólido, el campeón defensor dominó 15-3 frente a una Argentina errática, consagrándose bicampeón.

Brasil superó en ataque (62-51) y bloqueo (16-8), mientras ambos equipos igualaron con 7 puntos de servicio. Los errores fueron similares: 27 de Brasil y 26 de Argentina.

El máximo anotador del encuentro fue el brasileño Samuel Carazzai con 31 puntos, incluidos 5 aces. Lo acompañaron Maicon dos Santos con 21 y Guilherme Amorim con 16. Por Argentina, el capitán Denis Cabañas marcó 24 puntos (4 aces), seguido por Nahuel Rojas con 18 y Nahuel García con 12.

Medalla de Bronce – Cuba 3, México 1

Cuba conquistó la medalla de bronce al superar a México 3-1 (22-25, 25-13, 25-18, 25-23), y aseguró además una plaza para los Juegos Panamericanos de Lima 2027 como el mejor equipo ubicado de NORCECA. México inició con fuerza gracias al aporte ofensivo de Jared Toy y Eduardo Garza, logrando ventaja en el primer parcial (10-8). Pese a los intentos defensivos de Cuba sobre la red, México impuso su ritmo para adelantarse en el marcador. El conjunto cubano reaccionó con contundencia en el segundo set, dominando 14-5 con

protagonismo de Alejandro González y el central Thiago Suárez. Los bloqueos se convirtieron en la clave de Cuba, con Yusniel González y Alexis Wilson sumándose a la férrea defensa para empatar el encuentro. En el tercer set, el servicio de Alejandro González mantuvo a Cuba al frente (11-4). México respondió con Toy y Jorge Hernández, pero los caribeños mantuvieron la ventaja para adelantarse 2-1. El cuarto parcial fue de alta tensión, con México arriba 18-16 tras errores cubanos y un ace de Alexis Alvarado. Sin embargo, la ofensiva de Thiago Suárez y Yusniel González revirtió el marcador y selló la victoria que otorgó a Cuba el bronce y la clasificación a Lima 2027. Cuba dominó en las estadísticas con una amplia ventaja en bloqueo (14-4), ataque (55-45) y ligera en servicio (3-2), aunque concedió más puntos por errores (28-25). El opuesto cubano, Alejandro González, fue el máximo anotador del encuentro con 23 puntos (17 ataques, 4 bloqueos, 2 aces), seguido por Yusniel González con 18 (14 ataques, 3 bloqueos, 1 ace) y Thiago Suárez con 12 (9 ataques, 3 bloqueos). Por México, los más destacados fueron Jared Toy con 15 puntos y Jorge Hernández con 11.

República Dominicana 3, Colombia 0

República Dominicana se quedó con el quinto lugar tras vencer a Colombia en un emocionante duelo de cinco sets 3-2 (25-20, 25-19, 21-25, 19-25, 15-10). El conjunto dominicano cerró el torneo con récord de 2-3, mientras que Colombia finalizó con 2-4. Los caribeños dominaron los dos primeros sets gracias a su ataque y al servicio de Malik Britton y Adrian Figueroa, que desestabilizó la recepción colombiana. Sin embargo, los sudamericanos reaccionaron con un sólido bloqueo para igualar el encuentro y forzar el desempate, donde finalmente República Dominicana se impuso con mayor contundencia. Los dominicanos fueron superiores en ataque (65-56) y servicio (6-5), mientras que Colombia destacó en bloqueo (11-8) y cometió un error menos (26-27). Adrian Figueroa fue el máximo anotador del partido con 28 puntos (25 ataques, 3 aces). También contribuyeron al triunfo Ronny Molina con 15 puntos, Malik Britton con 14 y Moisés Ortiz con 10. Por Colombia, el capitán Jhon Mosquera encabezó la ofensiva con 20 puntos (16 ataques, 3 bloqueos y un ace), apoyado por Miguel Rodríguez con 16, y Ronnie Mosquera junto a Carlos Martínez con 13 cada uno.

Guatemala 3, Paraguay 2

Guatemala se despidió con una victoria sobre Paraguay por 3-2 (18-25, 25-22, 22-25, 26-24, 15-13), asegurando el séptimo lugar. El conjunto guatemalteco cerró con récord de 2 victorias y 4 derrotas; ambas victorias sobre Paraguay que no logró sumar triunfos en la competencia. Los anfitriones estuvieron cerca de liquidar el partido en cuatro sets, pero Guatemala remontó un déficit de cuatro puntos (20-24) en el cuarto parcial para forzar el desempate. La celebración llegó con un ataque de Yeferson Zavala que selló el triunfo. Guatemala marcó ligera ventaja en el servicio (5-4) y aprovechó 30 errores de Paraguay frente a 24 propios. Ambos equipos sumaron 63 puntos de ataque, mientras que los paraguayos dominaron en bloqueo 18-8. Pablo Pérez fue la figura guatemalteca con 19 puntos (18 ataques, 1 bloqueo), seguido por el capitán Jerry Durán con 18 (16 ataques, 1 bloqueo, 1 ace) y Luis Mendizábal con 14 (11 ataques, 2 bloqueos, 1 ace). Por Paraguay, Alejandro López brilló como máximo anotador del encuentro con 35 puntos, apoyado por Milton Pérez con 14 (11 ataques, 2 bloqueos, 1 ace), Elías Amarilla con 11 y tanto Tobías Brizuela como Ángel Sánchez con 10 cada uno.
