Mexico and Peru Open U17 Campaigns with Victories, Puerto Rico Claims First Win

TEGUCIGALPA, Honduras, May 27, 2026.– Mexico and Peru celebrated winning debuts on the second day of competition at the Girls' U17 Pan American Cup, while Puerto Rico captured its first victory in dramatic fashion at the Jorge Galeano Gymnasium in Tegucigalpa, Honduras.

Mexico survived a hard-fought five-set battle against Costa Rica in its opening match, Peru rallied past Canada after dropping the first set, and Puerto Rico edged the Dominican Republic in a thrilling contest to secure its first win of the tournament.

Pool play concludes on Thursday, when the final standings will determine the top two first-place teams of each pool advancing directly to the semifinals.

Mexico 3, Costa Rica 2

Mexico survived a hard-fought five-set battle against Costa Rica to earn its first victory at the Girls' U17 Pan American Cup, prevailing 3-2 (18-25, 25-10, 25-13, 22-25, 15-13). Mexico (1-0) and will face Venezuela (1-0) for first place in Pool C. The top two best-ranked first-place teams from the three pools advance directly to the semifinals. Costa Rica concluded pool play with a 0-2 record. The opening set featured close exchanges and long rallies, with Costa Rica taking control after building a three-point advantage at 17-14 behind strong service pressure from Esmeralda Ugalde. The combination of offensive contribution from Charlotte Martinez and Luciana Vargas, along with Mexican errors, allowed the Central Americans to maintain momentum and claim the set. Mexico responded strongly in the second set, quickly establishing a commanding 12-2 lead with Emily Camarena leading the offense and Katherine Camacho providing solid support. Mexico comfortably tied the match with dominant attacking and improved defensive organization. In the third set, Catherine Camacho spearheaded Mexico's offense as the team jumped ahead 15-7. Evelyn Diaz also contributed key points, while a decisive 6-0 scoring run helped Mexico move ahead two sets to one. The fourth set was intensely contested, remaining tied until 21-all. Camarena led Mexico's attack while Ugalde kept Costa Rica in contention. Play was briefly interrupted at 11-all due to rain leaks in the gymnasium ceiling. Costa Rica capitalized on the momentum after the pause, fueled by Ugalde, Kyara Reyes and several Mexican errors, forcing a deciding fifth set. Costa Rica's blocking edge over Mexico proved significant throughout the fifth set, but Mexico managed to survive a tense tie-break to secure the victory. Mexico finished with advantages in kills (58-36) and aces (10-9), while Costa Rica held the edge in blocks (9-5). Both teams committed 32 unforced errors. Mexico was led offensively by Katherine Camacho with 23 points, Emily Camarena with 13 points, and Evelyn Diaz with 12 points. Costa Rica's top scorer was Esmeralda Ugalde with 17 points, supported by Charlotte Martinez with 11 points and Luciana Vargas with 10 points.

Puerto Rico 3, Dominican Republic 2

Puerto Rico earned its first victory at the Girls' U17 Pan American Cup after surviving a roller coaster five-set battle against Dominican Republic, winning 3-2 (16-25, 25-21, 26-28, 25-20, 15-8). Puerto Rico finished Pool A with a 1-1 record. Dominican Republic (0-1) will face the United States (1-0) in its final pool-play match. The top two first ranked teams from the preliminary round advance directly to the semifinals, while the third-ranked first placed team



advances to the quarterfinals. Dominican Republic opened the match strongly behind the offensive efforts of Shanty Perez, Paola De Jesús Dionicio and Leandry Almonte. Their attacking efficiency neutralized Puerto Rico and helped the Dominicans secure the first set comfortably. The second set featured closer scores throughout. Middle blocker Eliany Quiñones delivered key points for Puerto Rico, helping her team maintain the lead from start to finish. Dominican Republic's efforts were difficult as they committed nine unforced errors. Quiñones closed the set with a powerful kill after a reception error by Dominican libero Ella Genao. Puerto Rico again took control of the third set with Elizmar Vazquez contributing effectively in offense and blocking. Camila Colon joined the effort as Puerto Rico built a comfortable four-point lead at 17-13. Carinialys Kuilan also played an important role in keeping Puerto Rico ahead. Dominican Republic rallied from behind, narrowing the gap to 20-18 after a kill by Johanna Fanil Hernández and consecutive Puerto Rican mistakes tied the score at 20-all. Hernández then pushed the Dominicans ahead 23-21. Puerto Rico responded to tie at 23 with a block by Anna Aquino on Perez and another Dominican error. In a thrilling finish, both teams missed opportunities to close the set before Perez scored three consecutive attack points to give Dominican Republic a 2-1 lead in the match. The fourth set mirrored the intensity of the third. Puerto Rico led behind effective plays from Aquino and Quiñones, while Arianna Pantojas added valuable contributions. Puerto Rico's 14-9 advantage in kills proved decisive in forcing a fifth set. Dominican Republic recovered from an early 3-6 deficit in the tie-break to level the score at 6-all with attacks from Almonte and Perez, combined with a Puerto Rican defensive error. Puerto Rico regained momentum with kills from Quiñones and Pantojas to move ahead 10-7 and remained in control the rest of the way. Arianna Pantojas sealed the victory with a powerful attack. Puerto Rico held a significant advantage in serves (11-5) and benefited from 36 Dominican errors compared to 28 of their own. Dominican Republic led in attacks (60-51). Both teams recorded nine blocks. Four Puerto Rican players finished in double figures: Anna Aquino with 14 points, Eliany Quiñones with 14, Arianna Pantojas with 12 and Carinialys Kuilan with 12. Dominican opposite hitter Shanty Ivette Perez and outside hitter Leandry Almonte led all scorers in the match with 26 and 24 points respectively.

Peru 3, Canada 1

Peru bounced back after dropping the opening set to defeat Canada 3-1 (19-25, 25-20, 25-19, 25-12) in its debut at the Girls' U17 Pan American Cup. Peru has a 1-0 record in Pool B and will face host Honduras (0-1) on Thursday in its final preliminary-round match. Canada concluded pool play with a 1-1 record. Canada controlled the opening set from start to finish, holding the advantage in attacks 14-9 behind the offense of Naya Grimm and Ella Grapentine. Peru's Fernanda Pinto kept her team competitive with key points throughout the set. The second set remained close early on, tied at 10 before Peru surged ahead on a three-point run fueled by Pinto's offense and an ace from Mireya Maldonado. Peru maintained momentum with attacks from Tamara Galdos and middle blocker Kiara Lazo. Canada fought off two set points, but Lazo sealed the set with a decisive kill to level the match at one set apiece. Set three featured intense back-and-forth action, tied at 11 before Peru gained the edge with a Galdos attack and a block by Avril Moran over Madison Yamazaki. Peru widened the gap to 20-16 with strong offense from Valentina Valera, while a kill from Nahir Cueva secured the set and a 2-1 advantage for the South Americans. Peru showed clear improvement and confidence in the fourth set, dominating from the start and keeping Canada out of rhythm with consistent offense and pressure from the service line. Peru finished with advantages in attacks (49-37) and service aces (8-5), while Canada led in blocks (7-3). Peru committed 27 errors



compared to Canada's 34. Fernanda Pinto led all scorers with 17 points for Peru, followed by Nahir Cueva with 11 points. Canada's leading scorer was Naya Grimm with 11 points.

México y Perú debutan con triunfo en la Sub-17, Puerto Rico consigue su primera victoria

TEGUCIGALPA, Honduras, 27 de mayo de 2026.— México y Perú celebraron triunfos en sus debuts durante la segunda jornada de competencia de la Copa Panamericana Sub-17 Femenina, mientras que Puerto Rico consiguió su primera victoria de manera dramática en el Gimnasio Jorge Galeano de Tegucigalpa, Honduras.

México sobrevivió a una intensa batalla de cinco sets ante Costa Rica en su primer partido, Perú remontó ante Canadá después de perder el primer set y Puerto Rico superó a República Dominicana en un emocionante encuentro para asegurar su primer triunfo del torneo.

La fase de grupos concluirá el jueves, cuando las posiciones finales determinarán a los dos mejores equipos ubicados en el primer lugar de cada grupo que avanzarán directamente a las semifinales.

México 3, Costa Rica 2

México sobrevivió a una dura batalla de cinco sets frente a Costa Rica para conseguir su primera victoria en la Copa Panamericana Sub-17 Femenina, imponiéndose 3-2 (18-25, 25-10, 25-13, 22-25, 15-13). México (1-0) enfrentará a Venezuela (1-0) por el primer lugar del Grupo C. Los dos mejores equipos ubicados en el primer lugar entre los tres grupos avanzarán directamente a las semifinales. Costa Rica concluyó la fase de grupos con marca de 0-2. El primer set estuvo marcado por intercambios cerrados y largos rallies, con Costa Rica tomando el control tras construir una ventaja de tres puntos (17-14) gracias a la fuerte presión desde el servicio de Esmeralda Ugalde. Perú mostró una clara mejoría y confianza en el cuarto set, dominando desde el inicio y manteniendo a Canadá fuera de ritmo con una ofensiva consistente y presión desde la línea de servicio. Perú terminó con ventaja en ataques (49-37) y saques directos (8-5), mientras que Canadá dominó en bloqueos (7-3). Perú cometió 27 errores frente a 34 de Canadá. Fernanda Pinto fue la máxima anotadora del encuentro con 17 puntos para Perú, seguida por Nahir Cueva con 11. La máxima anotadora de Canadá fue Naya Grimm con 11 puntos.
